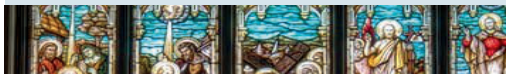

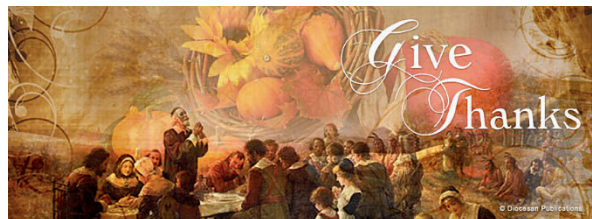

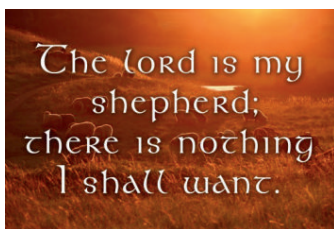
OLQA Flower Intentions
