On Saturday October 12th, All Saints Parish will be hosting a performance by the famed Tamburitzan folk ensemble from Pittsburgh at North Star High School in Boswell beginning at 2:00 PM. The Tamburitzans, who are comprised of elite student performers, have performed at some of the most prestigious concert halls, both nationally and internationally, for over eighty years. All the performers receive college scholarships as members of the Tamburitzans and are college students in the Pittsburgh area (the Tamburitzans were long associated with Duquesne University). The Tamburitzans help to preserve venerable ethnic cultures from around the world through lively dances, authentic instruments, vibrant costumes, and a variety of languages. Their presence in Boswell is a rare and exceptional event. Proceeds from the event will go to help fund All Saint's trip to Rome for students. Ethnic music, dance, folk attire, and language are part of our ethnic culture in northern Somerset County. This is a way to honor our ancestors and enjoy a true top-quality performance rare in our area. Following the performance there will be an after party featuring food from five different European cultures (Hungary, Italy, Croatia, Germany, and Poland) with a bar featuring beers and alcohol from around the world along with live music and games of chance.
