This is a way to honor our ancestors and enjoy a true top-quality performance rare in our area. Following the performance there will be an after party featuring food from five different European cultures (Hungary, Italy, Croatia, Germany, and Poland) with a bar featuring beers and alcohol from around the world along with live music and games of chance.
