RCIA

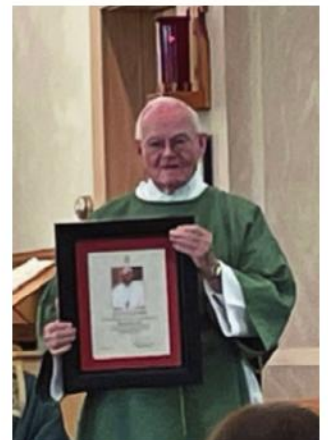
