Rorate Mass

Saturday, December 14th—St. John Site

Our Lady Queen of Angels will celebrate a Rorate Mass at 6:30 AM on Saturday, December 14th at the St. John site. The Rorate Mass is a very old devotion where the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candle-light. As the Mass proceeds, the sunrise approaches in the church becomes progressively brighter – lit by the sun as our faith is illuminated by Christ. The interaction of light and darkness speaks to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the World. The Mass will be offered in English and Latin with Gregorian Chant conducted by longtime friend of the parish Professor Nicholas Will.

Stewardship Reflections

Today's Gospel reading brings us to the very essence of a stewardship way of life, as Jesus responds to a question posed to Him by one of the scribes: "Which is the first of all the commandments?" His answer is a beautiful and concise description of a Christian steward's life: "The first commandment is this... You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Let's consider these 'greatest commandments' as they relate to the three aspects of a Christian steward's daily life – the use of our time, our talents, and our treasure. The use of time refers primarily to our relationship with the Lord – or in other words, our prayer life. The use of talents refers to the way I offer the abilities, skills and interests the Lord has given me for the good of those around me. And the use of material gifts demonstrates both a love of God and neighbor. When I trustingly offer a sacrificial gift to God through the offertory collection, I am showing Him in a very tangible way that He comes before all else in my life. At the same time, my gift is showing my love for my neighbor as others are helped through my financial offering.
