Some people who have attended past years have remarked it as the most sublime moment of their year. All are welcome to participate in this annual Mass - a powerful way to understand more fully the season of Advent.

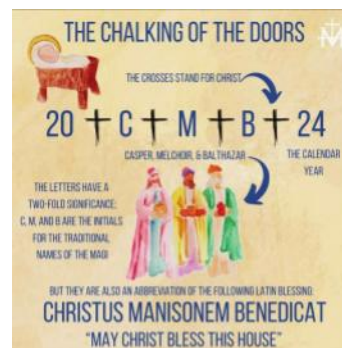

December 21/22, 2024

This year our three-parish community will celebrate, for the first time, a beloved annual tradition from Rome in preparation for Christmas - the Blessing of the Bambinelli. On the Third Sunday of Advent, the children of Rome are encouraged to bring the baby Jesus (Bambinelli) from each of their Nativity sets to St. Peter's Square. Following the Sunday Angelus address, the Pope blesses the figurines. Now celebrated in other churches around the world, this Advent tradition is a way for families to connect their Nativity scene at home to the celebration of Christmas at their church. In our parishes it will be observed at the end of all Masses on the **Fourth Sunday of Advent, December 21/22**. All the faithful (**not just children**) are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figurines from their home Nativity sets to Mass for this special blessing.
